To amend the Consumer Product Safety Act to modify certain postemployment restrictions applicable to officers and employees of the Consumer Product Safety Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,* That section 4(g)(2) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2053(g)(2)) is amended by striking out the last sentence thereof.
